

Minutes August 2020

Meeting of Llanfair Clydogau Community Council

Meeting held on 12th March, 2020 at Llanfair Clydogau Village Hall under strict Covid-19 guidelines.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING: These were proposed as a correct record by Dave and seconded by Alan.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES: The Clerk agreed to send the template copy of the Complaints Procedure to Glennis for her to amend and adapt to the Community Council's needs as required.

PLANNING: No new applications. No new updates on outstanding applications.

During lockdown concerns had been raised by some Cellan residents about the unlawful closure of a public footpath and allegations of unauthorised building work being carried out at Brooklands, Cellan. The concerns were such that the matter was escalated to Planning Officials as urgently requiring attention. A site visit was then made but the report sent back to the Clerk was that no breaches had occurred. It was decided that a request for a copy of the report should be made to the Planning Department.

CORRESPONDENCE: Thank you letters were received from Ceredigion YFC, Wales Air Ambulance and Lampeter Eisteddfod.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Alan had brought a copy of the Cambrian News to the meeting as there was a news article stating that a report had been made to the County Council about fly tipping close to Bayliau Farm in Cellan.

Dave updated us on a new UK initiative being launched for faster broadband as Ceredigion were being approached as one of the pilot locations. It was agreed that we would get some posters up around the villages and promote it locally.

One expression of interest was received in relation to co-option on to the Council. With two vacancies to fill it was agreed to leave the existing notifications up and a couple of Councillors would ask persons whom they believed may be interested, and report back at the next meeting.
