**Cyngor Cymuned Llanfair Clydogau Community Council**

*Minutes of the Meeting of the Community Council held on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2022 at Llanfair Clydogau Village Hall.*

**PRESENT:** Glennis Gratwick,(Chair) Cllr Odwyn Davies, Dave Bartholemew, Euros Jones, Ian Evans, Andrew Williams, Dai Jones.

**MINUTES:** Minutes of the last meeting, held on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021, were agreed as a true record proposed by Dave and seconded by Ian.

**MATTERS ARISING:** Odwyn will chase up the planning queries with the Planning Department. It was confirmed that the plastic balls outside the nursery in Cellan have been collected. Dai will check again with Ryan Jenkins the number of grass cuts he does at St Marys Church.

**PLANNING:** No new planning applications received.

**CORRESPONDENCE:**

- Queens Platinum Jubilee – It was discussed whether any other local organisations were involved in the celebrations. Dave proposed that we write to the chairs of Llanfair Clydogau and Cellan village hall committees and the Llanfair Clydogau and Cellan WI's to find out if they had any plans to celebrate. (clerk to send correspondence)
- Identifying Community venues to act as Emergency Rest Centres – It was discussed that in the case of an emergency then the halls would be used anyway. Dai confirmed that it would be considered at the next hall committee meeting for Llanfair Clydogau Village Hall. The chair/Secretary of Cellan Millennium Hall would be asked to consider the same at their next meeting.
- Laying of the Eligible Community Councils – It was considered what requirements were needed should we wish to become an eligible community council. Dai proposed that we should remain as we are and that we would not become an eligible council.. The decision was also made not to respond to the Draft Statutory Guidance that would support community councils to put in place the local Government and Elections Act (Wales) 2021 survey.
- Community council elections – this correspondence was noted.

**ANY OTHER BUSINESS:**

- It was discussed that more community councillors were needed. It was decided to ask for volunteers on the Lanfair Clydogau Facebook page. (clerk to do)
- Ian reported a fallen tree branch was blocking the passing place by Penlan Farm, Llanfair Clydogau to be reported to Highways dept. (clerk to do)
