- Welsh Air Ambulance and Noah's Ark – The Councillors discussed which charities to donate to it was proposed by Dai and seconded by Dave to contribute to all of them. Dave proposed to donate £400 to the Air Ambulance which was seconded by Euros and all agreed to donate £200 to each to the other two charities. Cheques to be sent out by the clerk.

- Provision of a public access defibrillator for Cellan & Ownership of the bus shelter at the war memorial in Cellan - Red phone box location - The councillors discussed that they would be ok with housing the defib there but there was a discussion surrounding the fact that there would need to be a pole erected for the electricity supply. Clerk needs to check with our insurance provider regarding cost. Bus shelter location -Yes, the Community Council own it and they confirmed that this is their preferred choice to house the defib. Clerk to relay information back.
- Use of Cellan Hall as an emergency rest centre- The councillors agreed to the use of both Cellan Millenium Hall and Llanfair Clydogau Village Hall. Clerk to e mail information back to
